The board of education will expect the superintendent to employ all appropriate means to provide for continuous and candid reports of the accomplishments of the students and staff in the pursuit of those goals and objectives for which reliable measurement indicators have been established.

The purpose of these reports shall be to provide the board with information regarding results and progress needed for making ongoing policy and planning decisions and to keep the public informed about school needs.
